COURSE GUIDE

The Graduate School of Library and Information Science provides an overview of courses as a service to students. This document may be used as a general guide; it is not a guarantee of offerings. New courses may be introduced that may affect this listing.

Students may begin the program in the fall (September), in the spring (January), or in summer I (May). LIS 701 is not offered in summer II.

Classes are monitored for frequency of rotation to meet student need, and are adjusted accordingly. This guide is not intended to address the location or time that a course is given. GSLIS has a diverse student body and an effort is made to vary class location and time.

The guide indicates courses for the summer term without making a distinction between summer I, summer II or summer III; students register for all sessions at the same time. When the schedule is posted the session (I, II or III) will be indicated.
